

#### Urban Lumber Mill Presentation Summer 2023



Jeff Perry, originally from Boston, developed a modern urban mill on the Boyle Heights side of the LA River in 2015. Warehouse spaces were available, and so were logs sourced from downed neighborhood trees. The budding mill accepted all variety of urban trees and committed finding uses for this timber.

Timing and place played a role in starting the business on the right foot. It happened that this rough area on the boarder of the Arts District was also home to many visionary architectural and landscape design firms, who quickly took a keen interest in the products and mission of Angel City Lumber. These relationships rooted in ethics continue to bear fruit as the Mill advances towards ten years of life.


